Read with Understanding: Galatians 5.13-26

Instructions

Carefully read through Galatians 5.13-26 and then attempt to answer the questions which follow.

Commentary

This section of chapter 5 may be broken down into 5 subsections. The following comprehension questions will be drawn successively from those 5 subsections.

Living Without License (5.13-15)

- 1. How is Paul instructing the Galatians to use their liberty (5.13)
- 2. How is the law fulfilled in a Christian? (5.14)
- 3. What is the effect of infighting amongst believers? (5.15)

The Promise of Victory (5.16-18)

- 4. What is the result of walking in the Spirit? (5.16)
- 5. What is the result of walking in the flesh? (5.17)
- 6. What is our relationship to the law if we are led by the Spirit? (5.18)

The Works of the Flesh (5.19-21)

7. In verses 19-21 Paul lists 17 specific "works of the flesh." What is his conclusion about people who do such things? (5.21)

The Fruit of the Spirit (5.22-23)

8. Paul speaks of the fruit of the Spirit in verse 22, the word "fruit" being singular. He then goes on to identify 9 things. What is the significance of that word fruit being in the singular?

The Provision of Victory (5.24-26)

9. Look carefully at verses 24 and 25. What does Paul say is necessary for us to do in order to live a victorious Christian life?
