5. What is the connection between weariness in the Christian life and fainting? (6.9)

Responsibilities of the Christian Life Toward All People (6.10)

6. What is our responsibility as Christians in living the Spirit filled life? (6.10)

Conclusion to the Book of Galatians (6.11-18)

7. In verse 11, why does Paul mention the fact that he personally wrote this Galatian letter?

8. Which verse in 6.11-18 do you think best sums up the substance of the message to the Galatian churches?

9. What is Paul's summary statement about the importance of circumcision (6.15)
